Did you know that,

- Between 40,000 to 60,000 people are newly infected with HIV every year?
- Half of those newly infected are under the age of 24?
- 25% of those newly infected do not know it?
- Hillsborough County AIDS cases account for approximately 39% of all cases in New Hampshire?

Despite advancements made in the treatment and prevention of HIV, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports that the overall rate of infection continues to rise.

The Thomas Cash Memorial HIV/AIDS Walk-A-Thon in Nashua is a 2-mile walkathon that benefits the Southern NH HIV/AIDS Task Force. The Task Force has been dedicated to providing bilingual direct services, prevention education, and leadership on HIV/AIDS-related policy and legislation. Your donation makes it possible to continue to provide services that are essential to combat this terrible disease. Picture how \$10 will bring one bag of groceries for distribution at our food pantry. Moreover, \$20 will give one hour of prevention counseling for high risk youth whereas \$100 will provide one month of mental health support group activity for one woman.
