



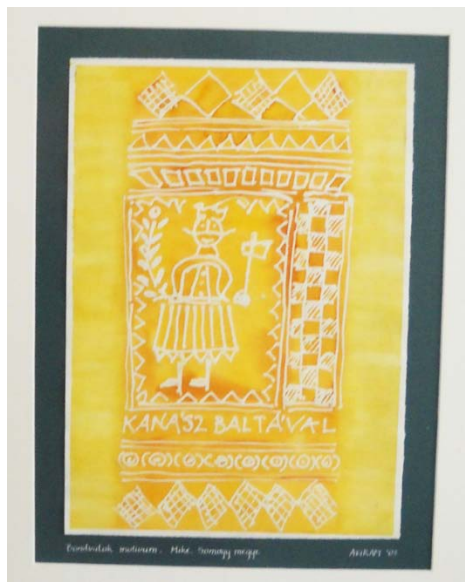

His watercolor paintings of places like Nantucket, Rockport, Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard and Provincetown are sold in fine art galleries all over the country for from \$400 to \$2000 dollars.

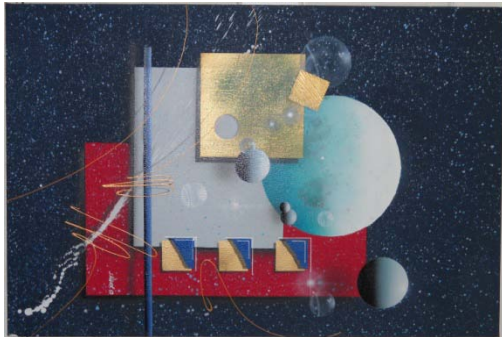

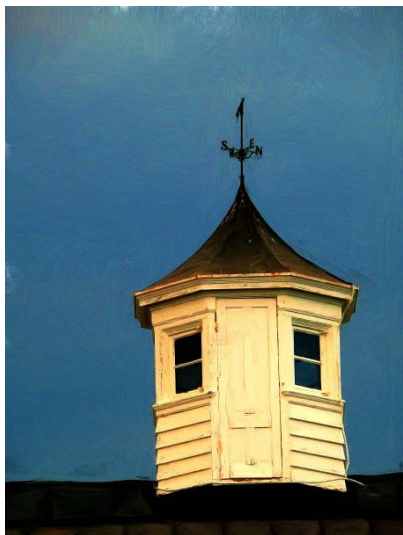

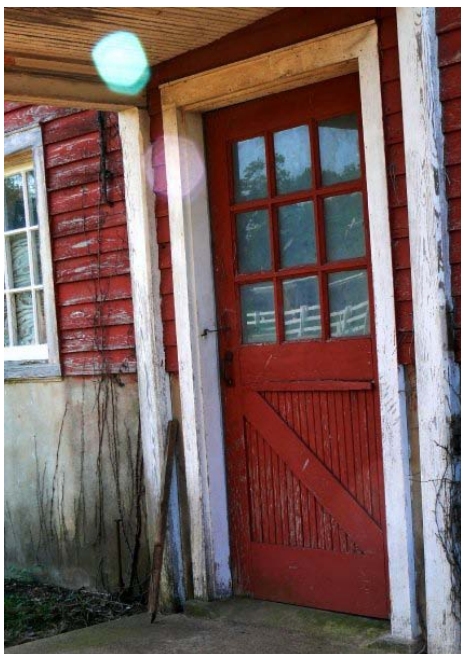

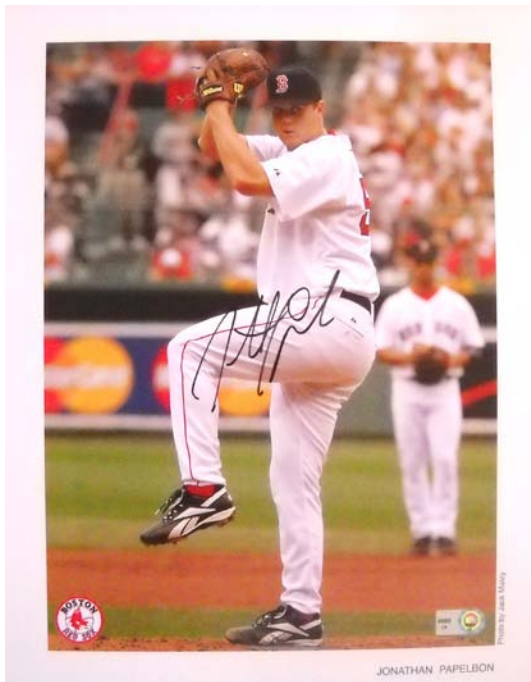

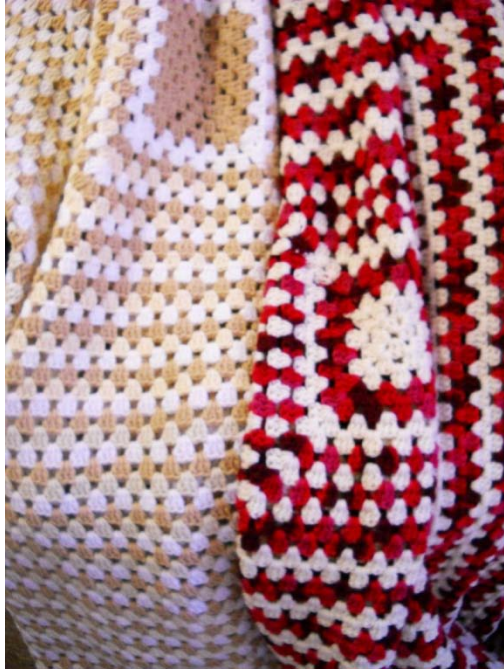

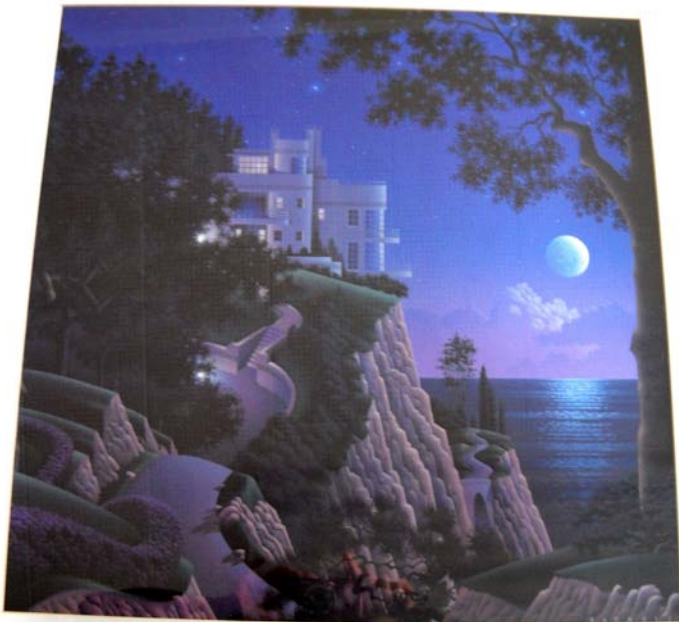
